The East Bay Community Law Center will be hosting **free legal clinics** for those needing assistance with **DACA Renewal applications**.

Who should come to the clinics?

Anyone who has a DACA work authorization card expiring on or before March 5, 2018. (If your DACA expires *after* March 5, 2018, you will be asked to leave a message on our general immigration intake voicemail.)

Where will the clinics take place?

How can you sign up for the clinics?

If you wish to attend our DACA Renewal clinic, please call (510) 548-4040. You will be asked to provide your name, phone number, and DACA expiration date. An immigration team member will call you back to confirm your clinic appointment time and date.

What do I need to bring to the clinic appointment?

- Your current work authorization card
- Your previously filed DACA application forms (if you have them)
- Your passport and any related travel document (if you traveled internationally since receiving DACA)
- Your social security number
- 2 passport-sized photos
- A check or money order for \$495 made out to the “Department of Homeland Security”
